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Inclusion

- ▶ Inclusion in our eastern WA branches: The AAUW-National MSD (Membership Service Database) lists nearly 600 women who are members of the national organization but are not Washington State or local branch members. While they might not be interested in attending meetings, or live too far from where meetings are held, they might participate in virtual events. Does your branch know who these members are, and have you ever reached out to them?
